What Makes You Anxious?

Ec. 8:7.

- I. God’s answer is not to deliver us from a future where bad things might happen.
 - a. God could do that if he wanted.
 - i. God does not promise perfect tomorrows.
 - ii. What God does is give us faith so we don’t fear tomorrow.
 - b. We often face the future faithlessly.
- II. Some questions:
 - a. Do I worry?
 - i. Worry is trying to live in the future.
 - ii. Matt. 6:27.
 - b. Do I wander?
 - i. Children of Israel and the spies.
 - ii. Churches do the same thing.
 - 1. They settle for camping instead of claiming.
 - 2. Ps. 112:1, 6-8.
- III. Three ways to face the future faithfully.
 - a. Look to the past for assurance.
 - i. When we remind ourselves of what God has dealt with it gives us leverage for what God will eventually deal with.
 - 1. What have you done for me lately?
 - 2. Matt. 6:25-34.
 - ii. Consider what God has done through salvation.
 - 1. Rom. 8:32
 - 2. That’s why we remember what God had done through the Lord’s Supper.
 - b. Living in the present with confidence.
 - i. Worry is a joy robber.
 - ii. Matt. 6:34.
 - iii. Phil. 4:4-7.
 - c. Leaning into the future by obedience.
 - i. When God says, “Fear not” he almost always follows it with a command to risky obedience.
 - ii. Joshua (a loose paraphrase of Joshua 3), “Go march at the river.”
