- I. Solomon's story does not end as well as it began.
 - a. 1 Kings 11:9-13.
 - b. believe that prosperity is a greater test than adversity.
 - c. Solomon slowly moves out of an environment where God is at the center.
- II. 1 Kings gives us hints along the way that his heart was starting to turn.
 - a. Unnecessary Alliances.
 - i. 1 Kings 3:1.
 - ii. To Solomon, this is an act of foreign policy.
 - iii. Trusting in the flesh is easy to rationalize.
 - iv. God's wants me to be happy. . . .
 - b. Unhealthy influence.
 - i. 1 Kings 3:2.
 - ii. Why would Israel go up to the high places and make themselves susceptible to idolatry? Two ideas:
 - 1. They had no temple yet.
 - 2. After all – King Solomon goes.
 - iii. Do you ever find yourself defending choices that could have potentially damaging spiritual consequences for you or others?
 - c. Unresolved conflict.
 - i. When David was King, he had a friend named Hiram, the King of Sidon.
 - ii. 1 Kings 9:10-14.
 - iii. Do you have any unresolved conflict in your world?
 - d. Unrestrained extravagance.
 - i. It took seven years to build the temple, thirteen years to build Solomon's palace.
 - ii. 1 Kings 9:15ff.
